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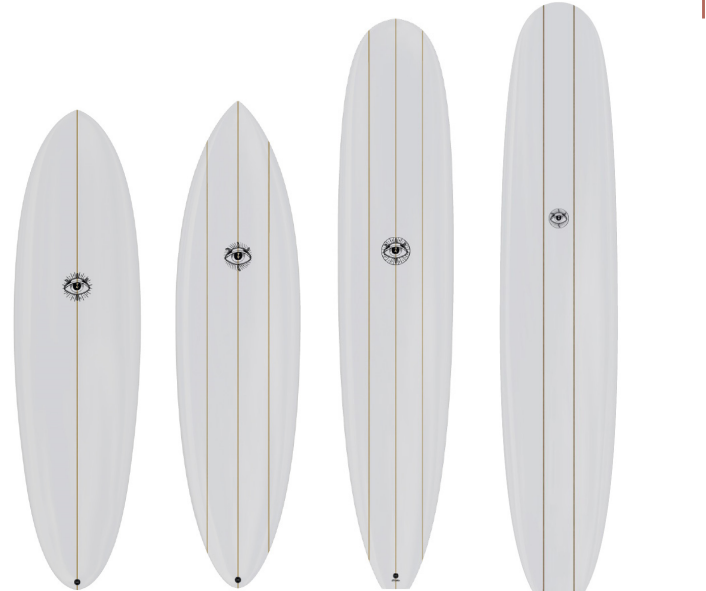

Despite the wide piggy look outline, this board stands out from the rest of our quiver due to its old school belly bottom - that runs all the way down to just above center of the board- and transitions smoothly over to a double concave throw-out the tail, this makes the board loose on your front foot and generates speed and control from you're backfoot. Make any surf feel like a playground when ordering the Porkstar about 7-10 inch shorter and 1/8 thicker than your usual board.

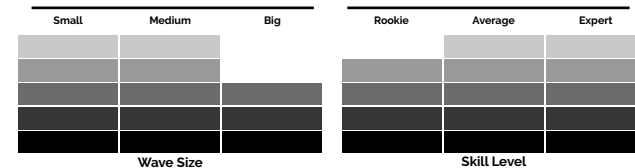

There is no doubt that the 'Sheeza Freak' makes a great choice when it comes to twin-fin fish for everyday use. Due to its outline and flat deck, we considered it to be one of the purest forms of the classic fish in our quiver. Despite its old-school twin heritage, the board has been refined to offer a more engaging and interactive experience. The board has a spiral-shaped V under the back foot and a more pronounced vee off the tail, which add to its maneuverability. As a result of the board's low entry rocker and volume distribution, it's easy to paddle and gets up to speed very quickly once up on your feet. According to where you are surfing, you can either ride it with keel fins or with upright twin templates. In terms of volume, we recommend going 3-4 liters bigger than your performance shortboard.

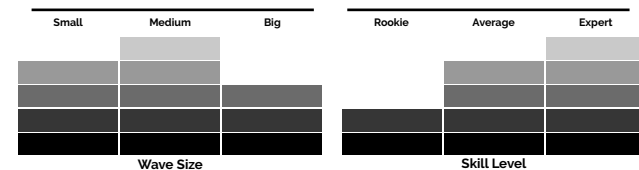

We're updating an ageless classic outline for the modern age. As a result of the low entry rocker, and the foam distribution pushed to the sides, this board generates speed effortlessly while allowing the rider good control and drive on demand.

Compared to the Sheeza Freak in the same series- the volume distribution for these models is fairly stretched out, whilst not having too much volume on the tail area, which makes for quick maneuvers in critical sections of the wave. In other words, we only put volume where it's necessary for making this board Magic!

We recommend you ride this board a couple of inches longer than your fish, and 1-3 liters more volume than your performance shortboard.

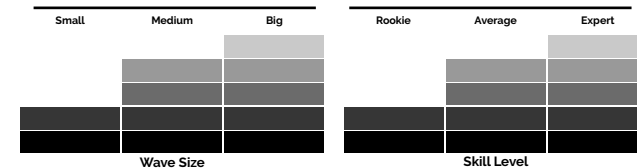

Introducing modern design details to a traditional fish template- enhances its ability to handle more critical maneuvers. The board's flatter rocker makes it easy to paddle and provides plenty of speed down the line, which is amplified by its channel, twin fins setup and swallow tail features.

As the board's bottom counter begins with a flat entry and high pinched rails for increased speed and liveliness, it quickly transitions into a double concave that changes into a V in front of the fins, followed by a separate channel throughout the fins for maximum speed generation once up on your feet.

We recommend ordering the McFlurryShake about 4 inch shorter and 1-2 L more than your normal shortboard.

Speed is the key to this board's efficiency. With this mid length, you'll have more buoyancy, speed down the line, and less resistance to waves compared to a shortboard. When on points or on the open beaches for those punchy hollow days, it glides and maintains speed effortlessly. The 'faces' of the channels provide additional surfaces to push against, and by eliminating the bottom curve, they create a straight-line drive. In addition to regaining thrust and directional force, the channels create a kick in the tail rocker, which, combined with the bite- allows the board to stay deep in the wave face while making radical turns in critical sections on the wave. Simply put, the channels are the ones that really set the thrust in motion. Channels on a board are really susceptible to chop on the water, so you would want to take this board out on big glassy hollow days to make it shine.

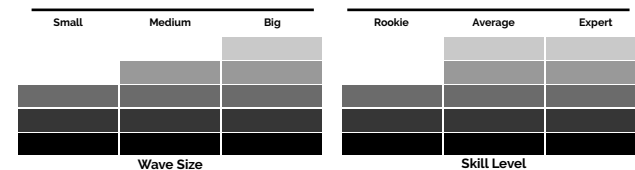

With the full nose and width throughout most of the board lend this board the perfect platform for any 'cross steps' or 'hang tens' you want to throw down. Whether perched on the nose or flying round sections in the middle of the wave, you will find yourself being able to generate heaps amounts of speed.

It features a tear shaped concave on the nose, which helps add lift when riding nose-to-tail. This is blended smoothly out to a flat midsection and into a rolled belly that empties into a vee out the tail.

The tail rocker on this board works in harmony with the pivotal turn design to produce smooth pivotal turns and cutbacks which corresponds with the long nose shape to keep the board balanced and steady.

The Padillac is an all-around performer with 50/50 rails and foil for the nose and tail, which adds a touch of slickness to the Padillac's overall performance.

Meanwhile, the Performer Round Tail has a more evenly balanced volume distribution for optimal performance. To fully enjoy the Mane-iac's capabilities, we suggest riding it 2 inches longer and with 2L more volume than your typical shortboard.
